The IPS is pleased to announce a call for applications for the 2018 IPS-Heidelberg-Award that will be presented at the 23rd International Visual Field & Imaging Symposium, Kanazawa, 2018.

### **Scope**

- Support of young scientists in innovative research on the interrelation of structure and function in glaucoma

**The requirements for an application for this award are:**

First- or second author in a publication which is accepted for presentation at the 23<sup>rd</sup> International Visual Field and Imaging Symposium in Kanazawa, Japan.

- Responsibility for the scientific content of the publication.
- Innovative work judged of outstanding quality in the area of the relationship between morphology and function as relevant to the IPS
- Membership in good standing in the IPS
- Maximum age 40 years or less in the year of the IPS Symposium.

**The award will be announced and presented at the IPS Banquet during the meeting.**

The sponsor may decide to divide the award to more than one winner.

The results of the award are final and no appeal is permitted.

**In order to consider your application,** we must receive in electronic format:

- The completed IPS Heidelberg Award application form
- A curriculum vitae (2 page)
- An abstract of the proposed presentation (1 page maximum)
